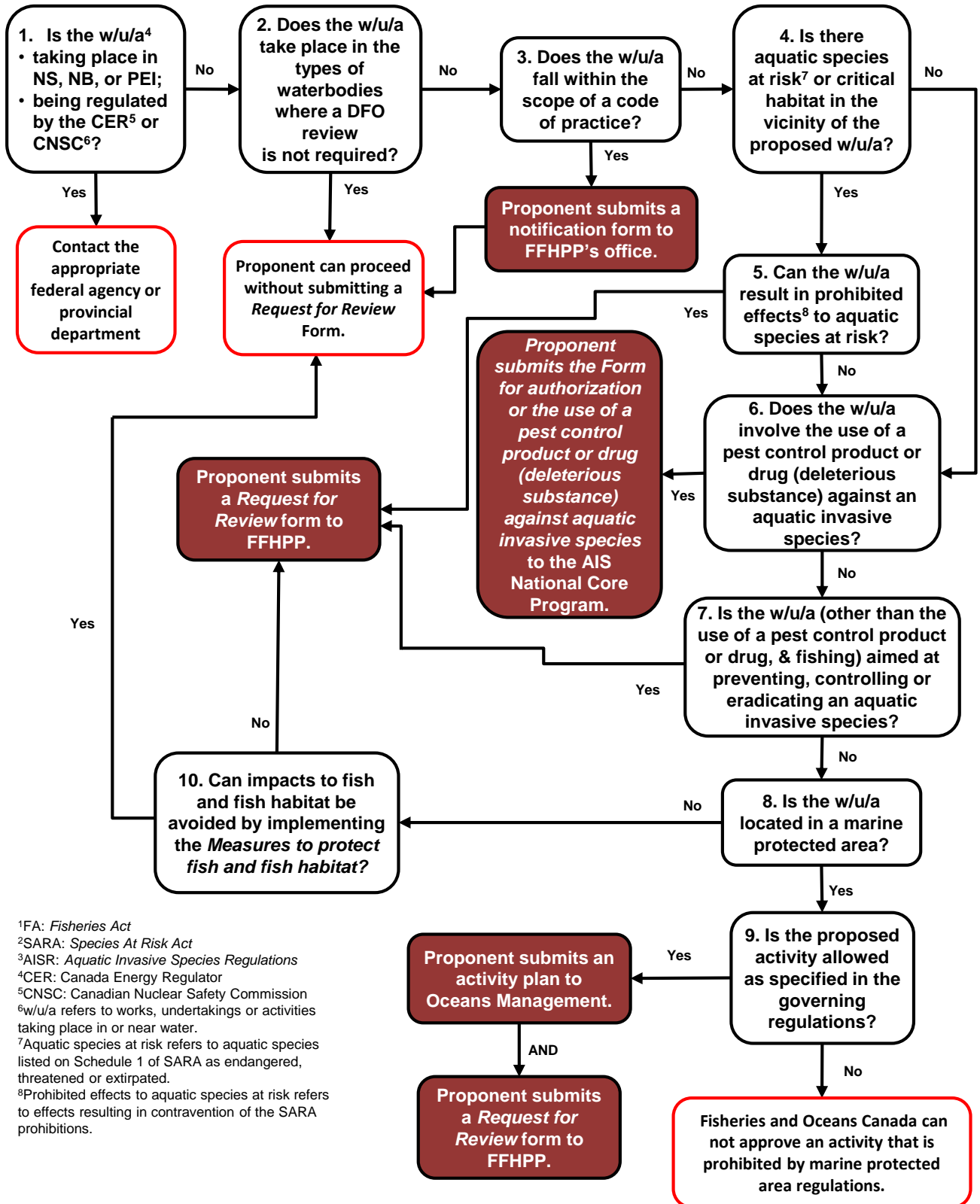


FFHPP Regulatory Review Process Map (FA¹, SARA², AISR³)

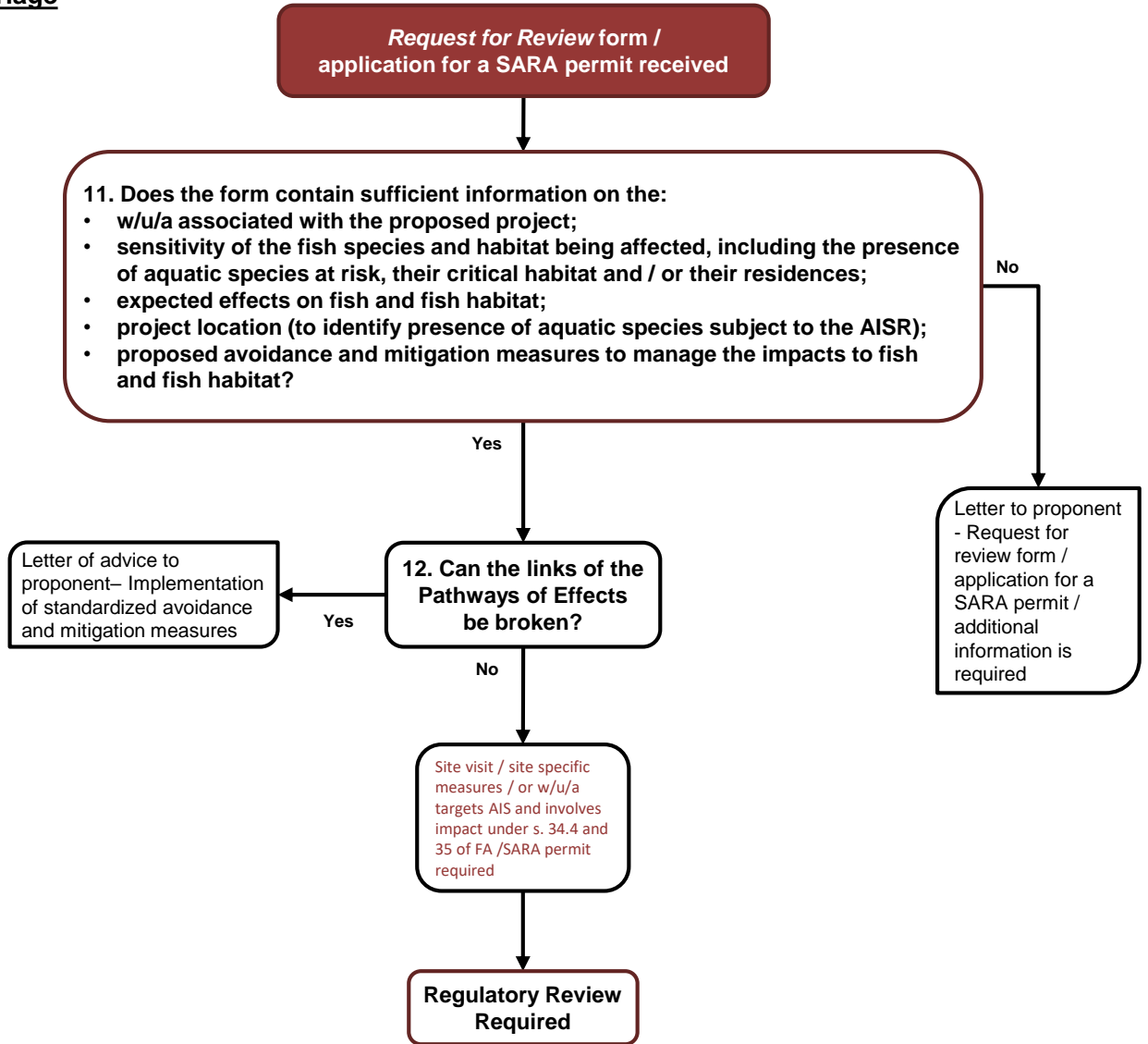
⁶w/u/a refers to works, undertakings or activities taking place in or near water.

⁷Aquatic species at risk refers to aquatic species listed on Schedule 1 of SARA as endangered, threatened or extirpated.

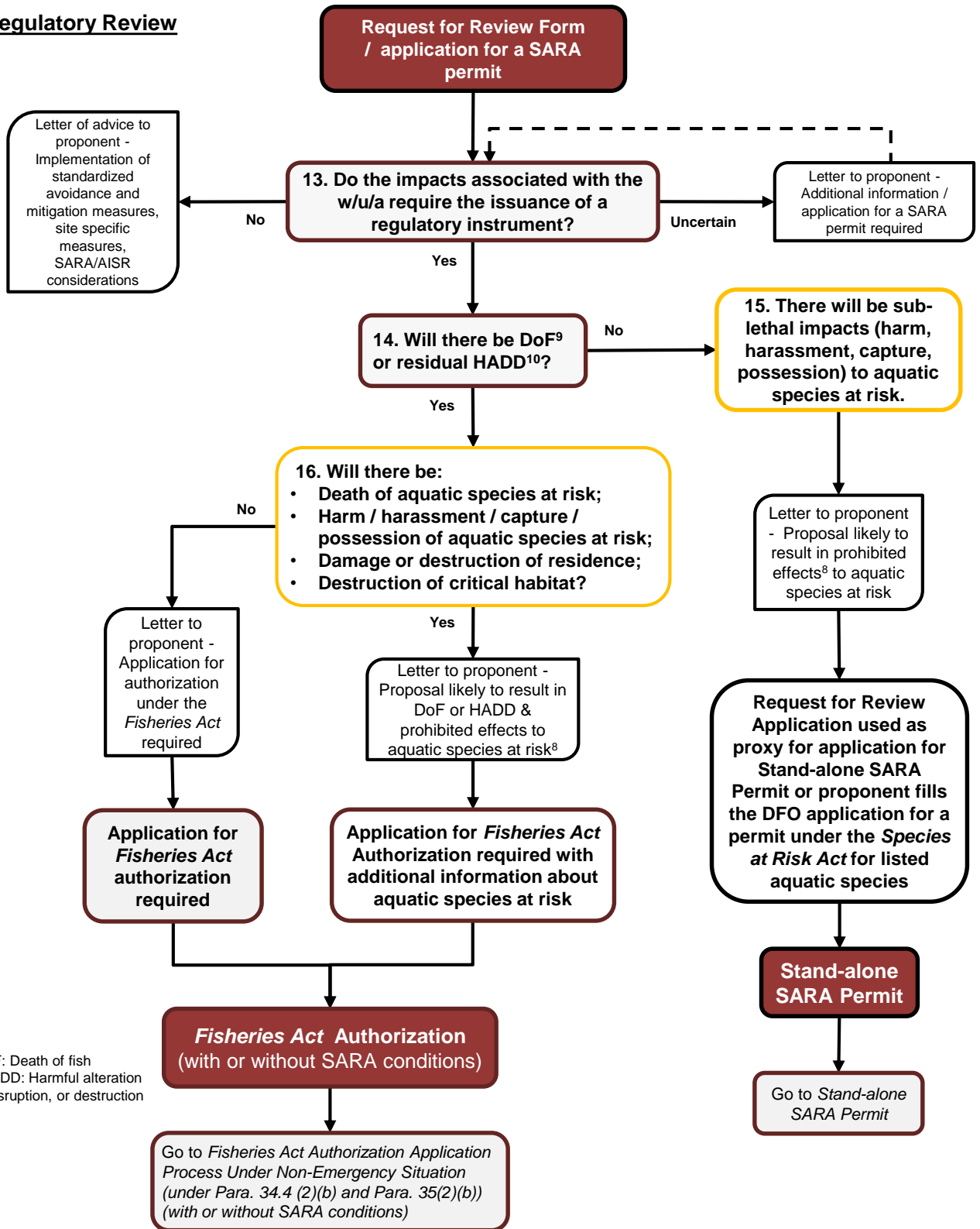
⁸Prohibited effects to aquatic species at risk refers to effects resulting in contravention of the SARA prohibitions.

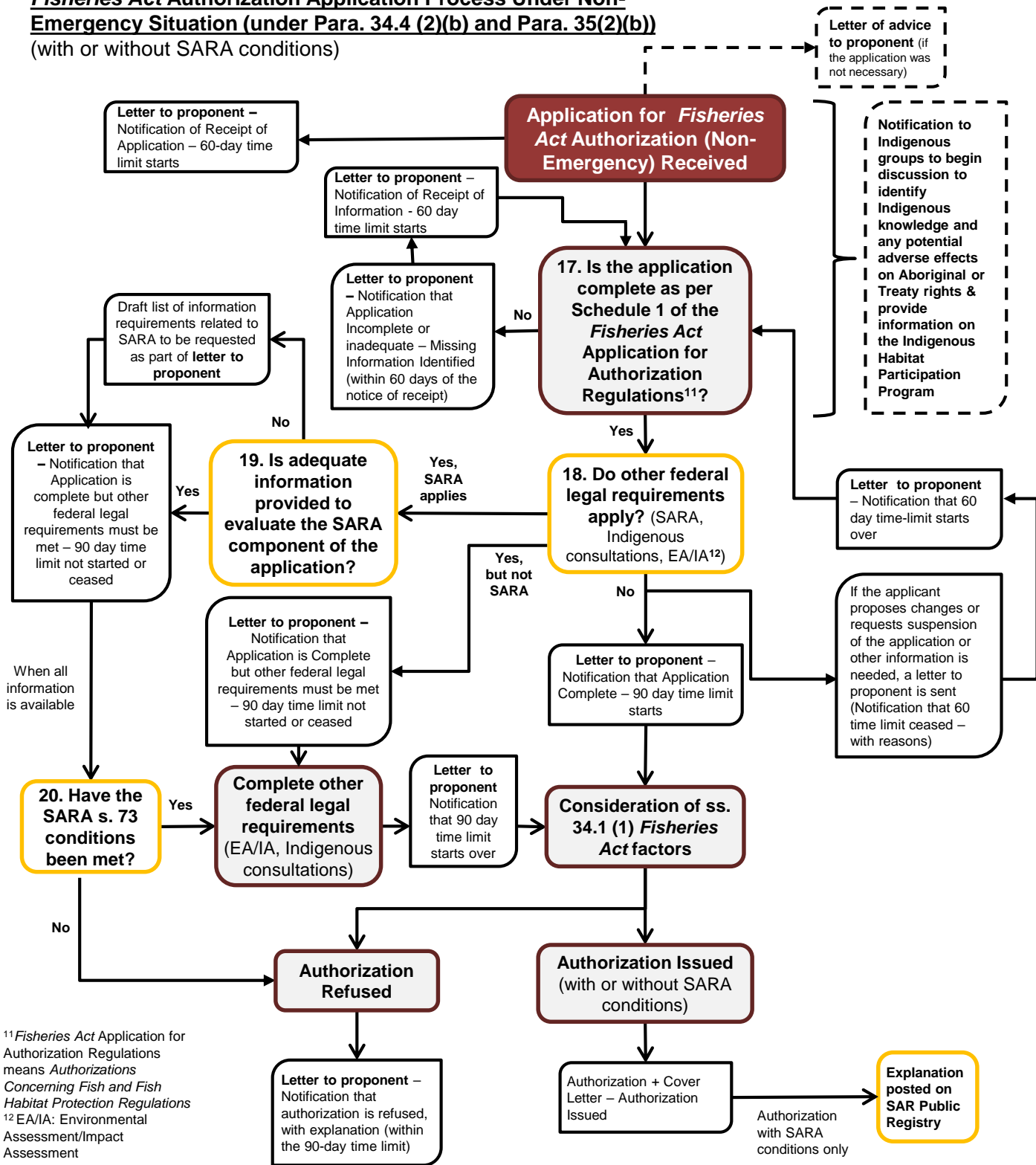


⁹DoF: Death of fish

Depending on the circumstances, a combination of different outcomes could be applied for the same w/u/a, e.g. a Letter of advice could be issued with a Stand-alone SARA permit, or a Stand-alone SARA permit could be issued prior to the Fisheries Act authorization, etc. This map is merely a way to represent in a 2 dimensional format, the various possible outcomes of the review of the w/u/a impacts.
