## 1. Maple Syrup Festival at the John R. Park Homestead Conservation Area

Explore the original homestead of John and Amelia Park. Carry sap on your shoulders and see it sugar off at the outdoor fire. Taste maple taffy made on the ice. Indigenous and pioneer maple making techniques will be demonstrated. Visit the working blacksmith shop and experience two uniquely themed weekends – Lumberjack Weekend and Tasters' Weekend. There will be iconic hands-on experiences for all ages throughout the Maple Syrup Festival.

Tap trees, move sap, and learn the early settler way of maple making with costumed interpreters.

Ruscom North Shore Farms is a small family operated Maple Syrup operation, possibly the most Southern in Canada. Trees are tapped and sap is collected by traditional methods, using buckets to collect sweet sap, which is boiled over a wood-fired evaporator. Ruscom Maple Farms carries a wide variety of sizes of pure Canadian maple syrup as well as maple butter and other treats.
